Yet a new era as in many New world countries started in early 90ties of the previous century.</p> <p>Since then many paths were walked and Slovenian wines have been highly prized by world authorities such as Wine Advocate, Decanter, Jancis Robinson, James Suckling, Wine Spectator, Oz Clarke and many others and are served in some of the top restaurants around the globe from London, Hong-Kong to New York and San Francisco.</p> <p>Slovenia excels both in producing wines from both regional grapes and international varieties, the later arriving in the country no later than in 1822, almost 200 years ago. What you will taste today is a “Tour de Slovenie” Slovenia represented in 12 bottles, some of which could easily fit even the most demanding wine lists. Very likely under the section “of the beaten path”.</p>

Speaker 講者**Mr Robert Gorjak, dipWSET, Managing Director, JR Wines Trading Company**

Robert Gorjak was grown up in a wine growing family near Jeruzalem in Slovenia. His passion for wine started in the beginning of 80' having had the opportunity watching the professional judges and tasting alongside them. His first article on wine appeared in 1994 and few hundreds have been written since. He is a contributor for Slovenia for the Jancis Robinson's **Oxford Wine Companion** and Hugh Johnson/ Jancis Robinson **Wine Atlas**. He contributed to several editions of Hugh Johnson **Pocket Wine Guide**.

In 2001 he set up with his wife Sandra first Slovenian wine school – **Belvin Wine School**, where he teaches and develops new programs and runs **WSET courses**.

He is the first Slovenian holding **WSET Diploma** and is an author of five editions of **Wine Guide – Slovenia**, where he has been rating Slovenian wines. He judges at International Wine tastings including Decanter World Wine Awards, where he was a Chairman for Slovenian panel. In 2012 he joined trade. He worked at Mercator, Slovenian biggest retailer as category manager for Wines and Spirits, now he acts as an agent for half a dozen top wineries from Slovenia, Croatia, Serbia. He is co-owner of JR Wines, a Hong-Kong based company who acts as an agent for Asian markets. His other activities in wine include education, consulting to the trade, event management, occasional writing and top-end tour guiding. He is about to finish an authoritative book “Wine of Slovenia”, which is scheduled to be published in 2017.

He likes skiing, scuba diving, F1 and playing keyboards in his rock band.
